How do I start Telescreen for my business?

Telepayroll will fax you several forms to complete and sign, in order to remain compliant with FCRA, DPPA regulations. As a user of the Telescreen program you decide what reports or searches to conduct and only pay for those you want. There are multiple levels of searches, for example, Federal repositories or State repositories. You always have the option to select the one you specifically want.

Fees are based on the search/report, and the level of information. From an address verification search of around \$5.00 to a nationwide database criminal search of around \$15.00. Since fees are based on report/search selected, you only pay for what you need. There is no minimum number of report/searches required. Some searches return immediate results, while other searches may take 48 hours or longer.
